National Statistics Bureau's Mandate

- Develop and maintain a National Statistical Data Bank to build time series database for the nation.
- Be the central apex body to validate, authenticate and disseminate national statistics both nationally and internationally.
- To ensure uniformity in the concepts, definitions and classifications to enable comparison of data at the national and international level.
- Be the central body to coordinate with sectors and provide technical support in carrying out plan for statistical activities.
- Closely interact with sectors and provide technical support in planning and designing of surveys for collection of primary data and help in identifying data needs.
- Bring out regular statistical publications – National Accounts, CPI, Yearbook, Bhutan at a Glance, Socio-economic indicators.
- Act as a clearing-house for all statistical related activities including data collection and publication.
- Conduct workshops and training to develop and update skills of the statistical personnel in the country.
- Conduct census every 10 years.
- Conduct regular yearly surveys to update data's on survey like HIES, BLSS, price etc.
