The National Statistics Bureau (NSB) is pleased to release the Producer Price Index (PPI) Bulletin for the third quarter (July - September), 2021. This is the 35th series of PPI bulletin published by the Bureau.

The PPI is a measure of average price change of goods and services over time. It measures price change from producer's perspective unlike the Consumer Price Index (CPI) which measures the price change from the purchaser's perspective.

Bhutan's PPI covers logging, mining and quarrying, manufacturing, utilities (electricity and water), transport and communication sectors. It covers domestically produced goods and services.

The NSB would like to express its sincere gratitude to all government agencies, private companies and corporations for providing the data for the publication of this bulletin. We look forward to your continued support and co-operation in future as well.

Highlights

Year-on-Year inflation

The year-on-year (YoY) inflation rate (as measured by PPI) for July, August and September as compared to the same months of the previous year is recorded at 13.10%, 13.66% and 10.58% respectively. On average this is an increase of 12.45% from the third quarter of the previous year (i.e., 2020).

The inflation was mainly driven by Mining & Quarrying sector and Manufacturing sector. Mining & Quarrying sector recorded the highest increase with 35.26% in all three months (July, August and Sept) followed by Manufacturing sector, which increased by 24.87%, 26.01% and 18.91% in July, August and September respectively. Within the Manufacturing sector, increase in price of basic metals was the main contributor which led to the overall increase. Price of Electricity also went up by 0.11% in all three months. Transport sector recorded an increase of 5.83% on an average due to the fluctuation in exchange rate and increase in the RSTA bus fare and taxi fare. Information & communication sector showed constant decrease of -7.65% in all three months. Prices remained same for Logging and Water supply.

Month-to-month inflation

The month-to-month PPI increased in July, August and September by 1.37%, 0.22% and 0.17% respectively. On an average, it increased by 0.59% in third quarter due to increase in price of manufacturing sector by 2.76%, 0.36% and 0.39% in July, August and September respectively. The Transport sector showed a slight increase by 0.32% on an average. The Electricity and Gas sector recorded an increase of 0.11% in July and there after remained same in August and September.

Prices remained same for Mining/Quarrying, Logging, water supply and Information & communication sector in all the three months.




Graph 1: Time series of monthly Producer Price Index (PPI)

Technical Note

Definition

Producer Price Index (PPI) is the measure of average change over time in the prices received by the domestic producer of goods and services. It shows the average change in the prices of goods and services with reference to a particular reference period known as Index reference.

Scope and Coverage

The PPI covers domestic produced goods and services that are destined for domestic as well as export market. The sectors included are logging, mining and quarrying, manufacturing, utilities (electricity and water), transport and communication sector. PPI is classified and compiled by activity (ISIC rev. 4) and also by product (CPC rev. 2).

Weights

Weights denote the significance or relative importance of each level or group to the total. PPI weights are developed using the total value of turnover figure from the establishment census 2010 by the Ministry of Labor and Human Resource and also the data collected on turnover of each establishment by the National Statistics Bureau.

Index Reference

The index reference for the calculation of the PPI is the September, 2011 which is normally set as 100.

Price Collection

Point-in-time prices are collected for the PPI compilation i.e., price of a product on the 15th day of every month or the nearest trading day to the 15th of the month.

Index calculation methodology

Geometric Modified Laspeyre's formula is used for compiling PPI

$$P_{gyo} = \prod_{i=1}^{n} \left(\frac{P_i^t}{P_i^0}\right)^{w_i^b}$$

Uses of PPI

- 1. As deflator in National Accounts to estimate the real growth rate
- 2. As lead indicator of inflationary trends
- 3. Indexation of cost escalation in long term contract of goods and services
- 4. Business analysis
- 5. Current cost accounting

Calculating Index Changes

Movement of Price index from one month to another is usually expressed in term of percent changes, rather than as changes in index points. Index point changes are affected by the level of the index in relation to its base period, whereas percent changes are not. The following example shows the computation of index point and percent changes.
