Preamble

The Performance Agreement is entered into between the Prime Minister and the Director General of National Statistics Bureau (NSB)

The objectives of this Performance Agreement are:

- a) To establish clarity and consensus about annual priorities for the National Statistics Bureau (NSB) consistent with the 11th Five Year Plan, and Government's other priorities;
- b) To make the NSB fully responsible for driving implementation and delivering the results against the annual priorities; and
- c) To provide an objective and fair basis for evaluating the NSB's overall performance at the end of year.

The Performance Agreement represents an important accountability mechanism for inculcating a performance based culture at all levels of government.

THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

Section 1: Vision, Mission and Objectives

Vision

Support evidence-based policy/decision making in the country, and be a key provider of world class statistical information.

Mission

- Provide timely, relevant and reliable statistics consistent with international principles and standard for effective decision making and monitoring; and
- Be a key provider of internationally comparable statistical information.

Objectives

To enhance rural livelihood with good local governance in line with culture and environment.

- 1. Develop national statistics development strategy (NSDS);
- 2. Draft statistics bill of Bhutan (Statistical Legislation);
- 3. Conduct socio-economic and thematic research;
- 4. Conduct population housing census of Bhutan (PHCB);
- 5. Collect and publish monthly, quarterly and annual official statistics reports;
- 6. Develop environmental statistics and accounting;
- 7. Develop micro-data dissemination policy; and
- 8. Establish geog level data centre in two pilot Dzongkhags.
