

# PERFORMANCE AGREEMENT BETWEEN PRIME MINISTER AND DIRECTOR National Statistics Bureau

(July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022)

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### **Preamble**

The Performance Agreement is entered into between the Prime Minister and Director, National Statistics Bureau.

The objectives of this Performance Agreement are:

- a) To establish clarity and consensus about annual priorities for the National Statistics Bureau consistent with the 12th Five Year Plan, and Government's other priorities;
- b) To make the National Statistics Bureau fully responsible for driving implementation and delivering the results against the annual priorities;
- c) To provide an objective and fair basis for evaluating the Agency's overall performance at the end of the year;

The Performance Agreement represents an important accountability mechanism for inculcating a performance-based culture at all levels of government.

THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

# Section 1: Vision, Mission and Objectives

### **Vision**

To provide high quality statistical products and services to support social and economic development of the country.

### Mission

- 1. To provide relevant, reliable, and timely statistics to facilitate planning and evidence-based decision making; and
- 2. To ensure that the compilation and dissemination of statistics are in accordance with scientific principles, professional ethics and international standards.

### **Objectives**

- 1. To ensure availability of timely, relevant and reliable official statistics;
- 2. To streamline and institutionalize standard data collection system;
- 3. To enable effective and efficient public service delivery;
- 4. To strengthen evidenced-based decision and data culture; and
- 5. To strengthen transparent, accountable and integrity consciousness and culture.
